- Prof. Naziha Grati Kammoun is Senior Researcher, Professor on Agrifoods industries.
- She is the head of research unit "Technology and Quality" at the Institut de l'Olivier Sfax (Tunisia).
- She is agreed IOC Panel Leader of Institut de l'Olivier
- She is an Expert on Genetic biodiversity of Olive Oil Varieties, Olive Oil Quality and Sensorial analysis of Olive Oil, Improvement and Valorization of Olive Oils by Label and Quality signs.
- She is an engineer on Genie Biology from the National School of Engineers of Sfax (ENIS) and Compiègne University of Technology (France).
- In 2006, She had her Ph.D. in Biological Sciences from Paris 11 Paris Sud University/ FSS with the theme: Genetic diversity of olive varieties cultivated in Tunisia: Pomological, Chemical and Molecular characterization.
- She was the first to publish impacted articles on the molecular diversity of olive varieties in Tunisia and among the first in the world. She has published over 150 articles in impacted journals and 20 chapters in books peer and 2 varietal catalogs of the olive tree.
- She is a regular invited speaker about olive oil around the world. She has presented over 100 papers and lectures at international conferences and symposia.
- She developed the specifications of the first geographical indication in Tunisia "Indication of Provenance IP" olive oil from Monastir which officially appeared at JORT in 2010, She is an expert to develop the technical criteria related to the specifications of the Ecolabel and Qualimed labels
- She is also an International contributor of FLOS OLEI, A GUIDE TO THE WORLD OF EXTRA VIRGIN OLIVE OIL. Editing Marco Oregia Italy, since 2008 and Member of International MONOCULTIVAR Olive Oil Tasting Jury during years 2017 & 2018.
- She is also the President of the "Olives and olive oils category" jury in the National Competition for Local Products (APIA Tunisia).
- She is a Tunac auditor and technical expert on laboratory standard accreditation ISO CEI / 17025 since 2007. Until now she is the only auditor ISO 17025 in Olive Oil sensory analysis in Tunisia.
- She is the founder and manager of "The best Monocultivar Extra Virgin olive oil Competition (registered INNORPI 2022).
- She is the co-founder and Vice President of Tunisia: Olive Association.
